DEADLINES: You can send in as many pictures as you'd like whenever you'd like as long as all your submittals are in by **September 1, 2011**.

CASH PRIZES: Cash prizes will be awarded to the winners and the photos will be used in our next AgriCulture Calendar, which will be issued fall 2011.

CONTEST RULES:

1. Each photograph must be accompanied by a completed application. If submitting your photos via email, please fax or mail in your application(s).
2. Photos must be **agriculture** related.
3. Photos can be color or black and white.
4. Submitted digital photos should be in **JPEG** or **TIFF** format and a **minimum of 300 dpi**.
5. Submitted photos must be **8 x 10 (unframed/unmated)** accompanied by a **digital file or 35 mm slide**. Photos submitted on plain paper, not photo paper, don't do justice to the photo. Digital file can be sent via email. However, you may need to send more than one email. If sending photos on a CD, be sure to label your CD with your name and "2011 Ag Photo Contest" and be sure the photo is in the right format and can be opened.
6. Each photo **must have a caption** on a separate piece of paper (can be taped to the back of the picture), which should **include subject name, the date and location the photo was taken**, and a brief explanation (optional).
7. **Photos must be taken in Wyoming.**
8. Before submittal, check the quality of your photo for clarity, focus and contrast. You don't want your picture to be blurry or dark. Be careful of editing your pictures too much; sometimes the full picture is the better picture, or submit both.
