STATE OF WYOMING WORKFORCE ASSISTANCE

The Workforce Development Training Fund is a unique program that helps employers provide training in their organizations. This Fund, administered by the Wyoming Department of Workforce Services, has established three different types of grants that address workforce training needs.

NOTE: The 2018 Wyoming State Legislature approved a new program in workforce training grants that will focus on ENDOW priority economic sectors (more details to come).
